"

"We have resumed production for a long time now and everything is back up and running. We also have a processed product called garlic rice. They are very popular, but in the current situation, the demand for this product has decreased, mainly because it is mainly used by restaurants, and most restaurants are closed now, so this also affects the demand for garlic rice. Therefore, we have put more energy on fresh garlic, and the market still has a lot of demand for this product, and the quality is still very good now, despite the end of the season. "
